#### Temporary Limitations and Restrictions.

- ALL persons must sign our waiver BEFORE they arrive at the Funny Farm: [Waiver and Release](#)
- Masks are required for anyone over age 2.
- Six-foot social distancing rules apply everywhere, and hand washing is required before and after you pet the animals.
- If you do not feel well, please stay home for the sake of others and the animals.
- Parking will be available inside the farm. Speed limit is 1 mph. Parking as always is at your own risk. Guinea hens, goats, and peacocks love to peck shiny cars.
- We will not be doing the Tucker demonstration at first because it gathers too many people together.
- We will not be doing hayrides at first due to social distancing rules.
- Barns will be closed. Everyone will remain outside.
- Our giftshop will remain open where you can buy little buckets of apples, lettuce, and carrots to feed the animals. Buckets are \$3 each.
- Restrooms are for emergency use only as we will have to clean and sanitize them after each use.
- Picnic tables are spread out. Please limit your stay to 1 hour or less if it is busy so that others may also see the animals.

We realize all of you have waited for such a long time and so have the animals, but please use common-sense for your safety and the safety of the animals.

Admission and parking are free however, donations are so much appreciated, especially now.
